



## **Yakima Klickitat Farm Association Scholarship Application**

The Yakima Klickitat Farm Association (YKFA) is proud to announce the availability of three (3) \$1000 dollar scholarships for this present graduating class and present undergraduate college/vocational students. Applicants need to fulfill the following in order to be considered:

1. Submit a current resume reflecting both school activities and honors; and, work experience.
2. Submit a cover letter describing why the applicant feels he or she is eligible and a good candidate for this YKFA funded scholarship. The letter should outline the applicant's prospective major area of study as well as the university or vocational program where the applicant intends to attend.
3. Submit a minimum of three letters of reference that speak to the candidate's scholastic achievements and/or work history. A balance of scholastic achievement and work history is preferred.
4. Submit your most recent educational transcripts.

The complete scholarship application packet deadline is April 15, 2026. Awards will be selected by May 15, 2026, and each successful candidate will be notified after that.
